



***TEAS Test (Test of Essential Academic Skills)
And
Critical Thinking***

All nursing students must take both assessment tests before enrolling in the nursing program at the Community College of Denver. For more information please visit: <http://www.cccs.edu/nursing/index.html#net>.

A valid government issued photo I.D. and a \$125 fee are required.

Testing is available **by appointment** during the following start times:

MONDAY	9AM and 11AM
TUESDAY	9AM, 11AM, and 1PM
WEDNESDAY	9AM, 11AM, and 1PM
THURSDAY	9AM and 11AM
FRIDAY	9AM and 11AM

CCD Testing Fee: A \$75.00 fee for the TEAS test and \$50.00 for the Critical Thinking test must be paid at the time of the test. We accept Visa, Mastercard, Discover, check, money order, or cash. You must pay this fee at the CCD Cashier's office (303-556-2075), SO 136, prior to your test. **Be sure to bring your receipt.**

Retest Policy: Students may retake the test once within a one year period. No more than one retest score will be considered for admission.

The CCD Testing Center is located in the South Classroom Building on the second floor in Room 223. You may park in the Tivoli Parking Lot (G) off of 9th Street and Auraria Parkway. Bring your parking ticket with you to be validated. The RTD Light Rail (D- Line) also stops at Auraria Campus on Colfax near the South Classroom Building.

Test 1

The **TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills)** is a computer based, multiple choice, **timed** test consisting of four sections:

Reading: (40 Questions, 50 Minutes)

Mathematics: (45 Questions, 45 Minutes)

Science: (30 Questions, 38 Minutes)

English: (55 Questions, 65 Minutes)

Test 2

The **Critical Thinking** (40 Questions, 40 Minutes) is a separate test, but must be taken with the TEAS test.

The combined time for these tests is approximately 5 hours, including breaks. Score results will be used for evaluation of the students' admittance into the nursing program.
