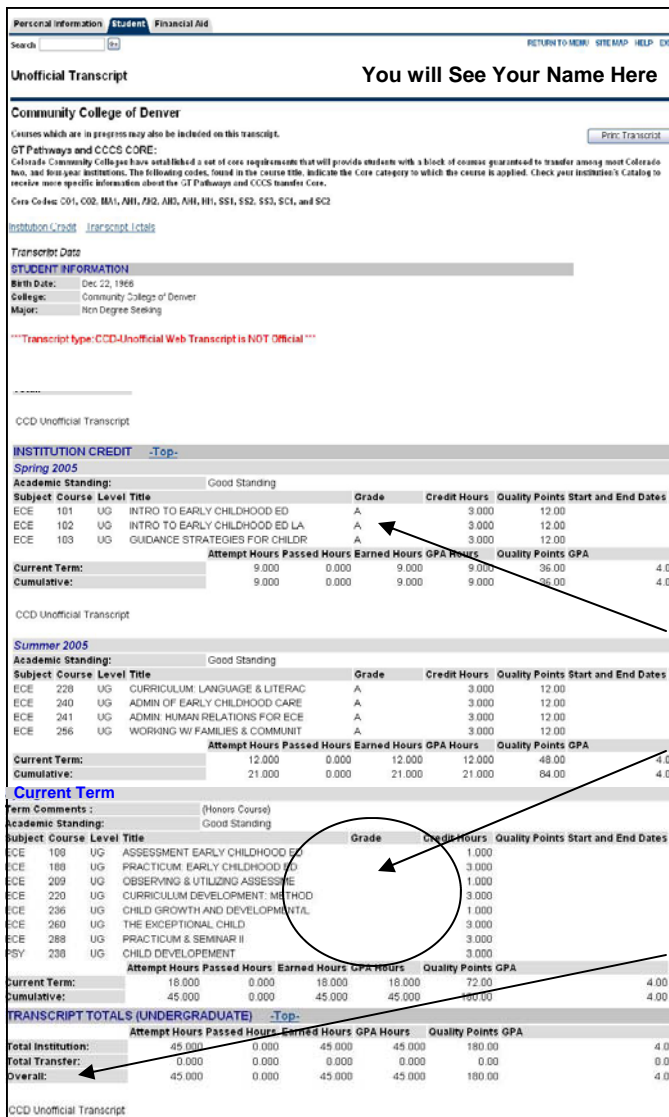


How to Check Grades Using Your Student Account, MyED



- 1) Go to www.ccd.edu
- 2) Go to **Links**
- 3) Click on **“MyCommunity Education”**
- 4) Click on **“Current Students”**
- 5) Enter you Student ID **“S”** number in the User ID field
-“S” must be in upper case when logging in
Enter your PIN (6 digits)
- 5) Click on **“Student Menu”**
- 6) Click on **“Students Records Menu”**
- 7) Click on **“Unofficial Transcript”**

- A.....Excellent or Superior
- B.....Good
- C.....Average
- D.....Deficient
- F.....Failure
- I.....Incomplete
- S.....Satisfactory
- U.....Unsatisfactory
- S/A.....Satisfactory (A-level) developmental course
- S/B.....Satisfactory (B-level) developmental course
- S/C.....Satisfactory (C-level) developmental course
- U/D....Unsatisfactory (D-level) developmental course
- W.....Withdrawal
- AW.....Administrative Withdrawal
- SP.....Satisfactory Progress

Previous semester grades posted along with term G.P.A.

Current Term grades are posted a week after your last day of class.

Example: If your classes end on December 10 then you would be able to see your grades on December 17.

The “Overall” line reports your total cumulative Attempted Hrs, Passed Hrs, Earned Hrs and G.P.A.
