The primary objectives in job shadow experience are for the student to:

- Gain an inside view at the profession of medical imaging.
- Meet currently employed registered Radiologic Technologists.
- Be familiarized with the imaging department and its equipment.
- Expand their knowledge of advanced imaging modalities (when possible).

Students should present themselves in a professional manner. This includes appropriate business attire – *first impressions are lasting impressions.*
