1. PURPOSE

To assure the Community College of Denver (College) maintains an atmosphere conducive to learning.

2. APPLICABILITY

To support and maintain the College's academic and professional integrity, faculty, staff, and students are prohibited from bringing their children to their work area or class.

3. DEFINITIONS

Children are defined as anyone under the age of sixteen (16) and not officially enrolled in a course(s) at the College or other institute of higher education on the Auraria campus.

4. POLICY

It is the policy of the College that children are not allowed in classrooms, offices, or unsupervised in common areas of the College. Exceptions would be a child coming to the College to attend a school sponsored event or commonly recognized events such as bring your kid to work day.

5. GUIDELINES

These guidelines will be distributed and made known to faculty, staff, and students and enforced by supervisors and faculty. College employees and students are advised to seek alternative child care in lieu of bringing their child to school.
