COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF DENVER DISPLACED AURARIAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Displaced Aurarian Scholarship is designed to provide funds for tuition and fees to students who were residents of the Auraria Neighborhood at the time the Auraria Campus was first built, between 1955 and 1973. The program extends to the children and grandchildren of these residents.

To be eligible for this program, students must be Colorado residents and classified as degree-seeking by the CCD Office of Admissions. This program only covers tuition and fees for classes taught at the downtown campus (Auraria).

Duration:	A total of 8 semesters, including summer semesters.
Amount:	The student's share of in-state tuition and fees for regular classes taught at the downtown campus (Auraria).
Verification of Eligibility:	All applicants must provide documentation proving residency for themselves, their parents or grandparents in the Auraria neighborhood between the years of 1955 and 1973. Birth certificates, school and church records, tax documents, newspaper articles, etc. may be used as verification. In addition, applicants must provide documentation demonstrating the relationship to the Displaced Aurarian.
Application Process:	Students are encouraged to submit the scholarship application once they have completed their Admissions Application to CCD. In addition, each applicant is strongly encouraged to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the current and upcoming academic years. Undergraduate recipients of the Displaced Aurarian Scholarship must register for the College Opportunity Fund (COF) each semester.
Selection Process:	The CCD Financial Aid Office will make all eligibility decisions and final award selections. Funding will be confirmed with the Financial Aid Office. Scholarship awards will be at the sole discretion of CCD and are offered to students who maintain a GPA of 2.0 or higher, are not in default on a student loan, or owe funds to CCD.
