1. Click Groups tab then click Create Group button on the bottom right.

2. New Group screen will appear. Give a name to your group and select the members from the list. Click Create.





3. Once you have created the group, WeVideo will take you back to the Groups page. There you will see the groups you have created. Double click the group name to enter the group page.


