1. Purpose

a. Community College of Denver (College) hereby adopts, in its entirety, System President's Procedures SP 3-50b, Civil Rights Grievance and Investigation Process and SP 4-31a, Civil Rights Grievance and Investigation Process (Repealed – See SP 19-60 Civil Rights and Sexual Misconduct Resolution Process). These procedures shall be used by the College when conducting investigations into civil rights grievances.
