Data at a glance:

- Full time students experience higher retention rates
- Female students experience higher retention rates
- Traditional students experience greater retention than students ages 25-49
- Since Spring 2011 students 50 plus have experienced the highest retention of all students
- Retention for African Americans has consistently decreased
- With the exception of Native Americans in the last 5 years CCD no ethnicity group has been retained at 50% or greater

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- Across multiple ethnicities spring to spring retention is lower than fall to fall
