DISPLACED AURARIAN SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

Amount:	The Displaced Auraria Scholarship funds the tuition and fees for degree or credential seeking students minus the College Opportunity Fund (COF).
Verification of eligibility:	All applicants must provide documented proof of residency in the Auraria neighborhood between the years 1955 – 1973. If residency in the Auraria neighborhood is tied to either a parent, grandparent, great grandparent, or any further direct lineage, the applicant must also provide proof of relationship to these individuals by means of birth certificates or other acceptable legal documentation. School records, church records, tax documents, mortgage documents, etc. can be used for verification of residency, and will be verified as acceptable by the Scholarship Team. Please contact the Displaced Aurarian Scholarship liaison at the appropriate campus for additional support or resources. An applicant may also qualify if they are able to demonstrate direct lineage to a previous recipient of a Displaced Aurarian Scholarship.
