WHAT IS WUE?

WUE is the Western Undergraduate Exchange, a program coordinated by the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). Through WUE, students in western states may enroll in participating two-year and four-year college programs at a reduced tuition rate. In all cases, WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition. Please note: WUE students must submit a new WUE application with supporting documentation for each academic year that they wish to remain in the program. Changing your State's Drivers license or state tax returns may affect your continued eligibility for the WUE tuition rate.

LAWFUL PRESENCE

Students who receive the WUE tuition rate are receiving a Public Benefit and must be verified for Lawful Presence as a part of Colorado's HB1023. Students must complete an Affidavit of Lawful Presence and provide a valid form of identification as specified by the law

APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

WUE is decentralized program in which the student applies to the institution of his/her choice, indicating that WUE status is desired. At this point this student applies as a WUE student claiming residency from a participating WUE state. In determination of the applicant's residency, the institution may require additional documentation. A student may request that the home state certifying office furnish a certificate of residence.
