




Abbreviations, Definitions & Symbols

Accelerated: A fast-paced, intensive learning option to complete course work in less time than a full semester. Accelerated courses are scheduled usually the first or second half of a semester.

Corequisite: A course you must take during the same semester

Prerequisite: A course you must have taken during any semester before this one, or an appropriate test series must have been completed.

Arranged: Class meeting time or faculty contact to be arranged. Call the academic center for details.

Combo Class: Combined lecture- and lab-based instruction. See instructor for times.

Days of the Week:

M – Monday

F – Friday

T – Tuesday

S – Saturday

W – Wednesday

U – Sunday

R – Thursday

Guaranteed Transfer Courses: The general education core requirements you complete at CCD meet the lower-division general education requirements of all public baccalaureate colleges and universities in Colorado. For more information download the college catalog at CCD.edu.

Hybrid Course: Course with both in-class sessions and online meetings, exercises, and/or scheduled discussions. [View Hybrid Course computer requirements.](#)

Late-Start Course: A class that starts two to three weeks after the traditional start date.

Learning Community Course: Two classes are paired to form a Learning Community in which students, ideas, and resources are linked to create a supportive learning environment. Students must register for both classes.

Online Courses: CCD online courses are listed in the schedule and are identified by section numbers that begin with "7." CCCOnline courses are identified by section numbers that begin with "C."



Steps to Success

1. Plan Your Degree Path

Meet with your Academic Advisor **at least one month before registration opens.**

- **First-time new students** – Advisors will help navigate the transition into college, including investigating choices before selecting a certificate or degree program, sharing college preparation course information, core program requirements and how to access college support services.
- **Continuing students** – Advisors serve as your 'graduation coach' and offer continued support focused on the successful completion of your academic program. Meet with your Advisor at least twice during the semester to discuss campus resources and your graduation plan.

Need to withdraw from a course? Talk with your Academic Advisor and Financial Aid for the impact on your degree plan and your aid.

2. Start Each Semester off Right

Use this planner to set class times, study and work schedules, and appointments with professors.

- Log into D2L and review the syllabus for each registered class and confirm important dates with your professors.
- Immediately add dates from the syllabus into this planner:
 - Exam dates
 - Project and homework due dates
 - Study group meeting times
 - Time to read, study and do homework
- Get your books and supplies before classes begin. Visit TivoliStation.com or participate in the Lending Library.
- Use your student email address to stay in constant contact with the College. Check this email regularly.

3. Be a Successful Student

- Advocate for yourself.
- Attend all classes.
- Participate in class discussions.
- Ask questions and listen to other students.
- Take notes and review after each class.
- Make an appointment to speak with your professor during office hours to ask questions and get help; do so before you are struggling.
- Visit our computer & tutoring services labs regularly for assistance.
- Know students in your classes. Form and attend study groups.
- If you need to make-up or retake an exam, contact your professor.

4. Get Involved & Have Fun

- Experience campus events, discuss hot topics and enjoy free food, see CCD.edu/Calendar.
- Join a student club by visiting Tivoli 260 or start your own.
- Check your email for the weekly student newsletter.

5. Campus Jobs & Career Exploration

- Get a campus job either as a work-study or student hourly employee. Visit [CCD.edu/Work-Study](https://ccd.edu/Work-Study).
- For Career Exploration, speak with your academic advisor.

6. Don't Forget to Register Early for Classes

Register early through Navigate to get the classes you need at the time you want.

7. Get Financial Aid

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa> or the Colorado Application for State Financial Aid (CASFA) for undocumented students at cdhestudentxprod.regenteducation.net/signin
- Priority deadline for financial aid and scholarships is April 16. CCD's School Code is 009542.
- To retain financial aid eligibility, you must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements, which include maintaining an overall 2.0 GPA, completing at least 67% of all attempted courses, graduating within 150% of your program length and completing at least one attempted course per semester.
- **Need Assistance?** For help completing your FAFSA, call TRIO EOC at 303-352-8746. For questions about your financial aid eligibility, call 303-556-5503.

8. Pay for Classes

Tuition is due the Monday before the semester begins. If you are approved for financial aid, confirm that your award is enough to cover the bill. If it is not, you must set up a payment plan for the difference. Check with the cashier for your payment options. If you register for a course after the payment deadline, payment is due at the time you register.

- If you miss the payment deadline, you may be at risk for having late fees added to your bill. Your balance may also be sent to Virtuoso Collections agency and a registration hold added to your account.
- Access your Student Refund Account (Bank Mobile) to select your refund preferences once you receive the information in your student email. Contact the Cashier's office at 303-556-2075.

9. Graduate!

- Talk with your advisor each semester to stay on track for graduation and transfer.
- Apply to graduate at [CCD.edu/GradApp](https://ccd.edu/GradApp) when you register for the final semester.
- Participate in commencement whether you graduate in the summer, fall or spring and **Celebrate!**
