Corequisite: A course you must take during the same semester

Prerequisite: A course you must have taken during any semester before this one, or an appropriate test series must have been completed.

Steps to Success

1. Plan Your Degree Path

Meet with your Academic Advisor **at least one month before registration opens.**

- **First-time new students** – Advisors will help navigate the transition into college, including investigating choices before selecting a certificate or degree program, sharing college preparation course information, core program requirements and how to access college support services.
- **Continuing students** – Advisors serve as your 'graduation coach' and offer continued support focused on the successful completion of your academic program. Meet with your Advisor at least twice during the semester to discuss campus resources and your graduation plan.

Need to withdraw from a course? Talk with your Academic Advisor and Financial Aid about the impact on your degree plan and your aid.

2. Start Each Semester off Right

Use this planner to keep track of your classes, study time, work schedules, and meetings with professors.

- Log into D2L and review the syllabus for each registered class and confirm important dates with your professors.
- Immediately add dates from the syllabus into this planner:
 - Exam dates
 - Project and homework due dates
 - Study group meeting times
 - Time to read, study and do homework
 - Get your books and supplies before classes begin
 - **CCDenver.bkstr.com**
 - Calculators and hotspots available to rent for free in Tivoli 260
 - Use your student email address to stay in constant contact with the College. Check this email regularly
 - Download Navigate360 to your mobile device

3. Be a Successful Student

- Advocate for yourself.
- Attend all classes, take notes and review after each class.
- Participate in class discussions.
- Ask questions and listen to other students.
- Make an appointment to speak with your professor during office hours to ask questions and get help; do so before you are struggling.
- Visit our computer & tutoring services labs regularly for assistance.
- Know students in your classes. Form and attend study groups.
- If you need to make-up or retake an exam, contact your professor.

6. Don't Forget to Register Early for Classes

Register early through Navigate to get the classes you need at the time you want.

7. Get Financial Aid

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at **<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>** or the Colorado Application for State Financial Aid (CASFA) for undocumented students at **casfa.grantpropathway.com/login**
- Priority deadline for financial aid and scholarships is April 16. CCD's School Code is 009542.
- To retain financial aid eligibility, you must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements, which include maintaining an overall 2.0 GPA, completing at least 67% of all attempted courses, graduating within 150% of your program length and completing at least one attempted course per semester.
- **Need Assistance?** For help completing your FAFSA, call TRIO EOC at 303-352-8746. For questions about your financial aid eligibility, call 303-556-5503.

8. Pay for Classes CNF 119 | **CCD.edu/cashiers-office/payment-options**

Tuition is due the Monday before the semester begins. If you are approved for financial aid, confirm that your award is enough to cover the bill. If it is not, you must set up a payment plan for the difference. Check with the cashier for your payment options. If you register for a course after the payment deadline, payment is due at the time you register.

- If you miss the payment deadline, you may be at risk for having late fees added to your bill. Your balance may also be sent to Virtuoso Collections agency and a registration hold added to your account.
- Access your Student Refund Account (Bank Mobile) to select your refund preferences once you receive the information in your student email. Contact the Cashier's office at 303-556- 2075.

9. Graduate!

- Talk with your advisor each semester to stay on track for graduation and transfer.
- Apply to graduate at **CCD.edu/GradApp** once you're registered for your final semester.

Extenuating Circumstance Appeal

The Extenuating Circumstance Appeal (ECA) allows students to request an administrative withdrawal (WX) or a review of past-due balance when a serious, unexpected situation beyond the student's control happens during the semester. This situation may affect the student's ability to attend or complete classes, withdrawal by published deadlines or meet payment obligations. Appeals are reviewed on a case-by-case basis and require supporting documentation. For more information, visit the Extenuating Circumstance Appeal website.

We do not take sides, but focus on fairness and problem-solving to support student success.



ACCESS & FUNCTIONAL NEEDS

- Ask individuals with mobility, cognition, vision, and hearing needs how you can best assist them
- Offer to help them reach a safe location, stairwell, or area of rescue assistance
- Notify emergency personnel of their location and how many people need assistance



MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

- Immediately contact the Auraria Campus Police at 303-556-5000
- Provide location, nature of illness/injury, the current condition of the victim
- Do not move the victim unless in immediate danger
- Administer First Aid/CPR/AED as needed



TORNADO

- Go to an interior room or stairwells, avoid windows, and exterior doors
- Follow instructions from emergency personnel
- After the storm, avoid damaged areas and debris
- Watch out for hazards like downed power lines, gas leaks, or flooding



HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

- Evacuate the area immediately and close the door to contain the hazard.
- Immediately contact the Auraria Campus Police at 303-556-5000
- Provide location, description of the substance or spill, and any known injuries
- Move to a safe location at least 300 feet away from the building

FIRE

- Pull the nearest fire alarm to alert others
- Do not use elevators
- Evacuate the building immediately using the closest safest exit
- Move to a safe location at least 300 feet away from the building
- Do not return inside until authorized by emergency personnel



BOMB THREAT

- If you receive a bomb threat, stay calm and collect as much information as possible
- Immediately contact the Auraria Campus Police at 303-556-5000
- Follow all instructions given by emergency personnel
- If instructed to evacuate, move at least 300 feet away from the building
- Keep access routes clear for emergency vehicles and responders



ACTIVE HARMER

- Assess your surroundings, determine the safest course of action, protect yourself
- Silence your phone and monitor for emergency communications
- **RUN:** If safe to evacuate, immediately exit the building
- **HIDE:** Find a secure location to hide and barricade
- **FIGHT:** Defend yourself from the threat with any means available
- Follow instructions from emergency personnel



SUSPICIOUS OBJECTS/ACTIVITY

- If you see something, say something.
- Report any objects that appear suspicious, out of place or potentially dangerous
- Stay aware and report any behavior that seems threatening, harassing, disruptive, or inappropriate.
