President: Spoke with Dr. Pirius regarding Tivoli Reimagined project and our survey of the student body over the project, how students use Tivoli, and aspects that are important to them.

Parliamentarian:

SACAB:

- Met with SACAB representatives to discuss priorities for the year, how we want to work together, and ways to increase SACAB/SGA visibility and student engagement across all three campuses.
- Continuing student outreach around Tivoli Reimagined. I created a flyer and student survey to gather feedback from CCD students and make sure they understand the project and have an opportunity to share concerns.
- SACAB is beginning to prioritize immigration enforcement Policy 7.7 and advocacy for undocumented/DACA students. I connected with Dominic, a former SACAB representative, who shared the work and policy analysis completed by last year's sanctuary policy subcommittee.
- I contacted Skip Spear at AHEC to determine where Policy 7.7 currently stands. He confirmed that SACAB's proposed revisions were already reviewed by the institutions. Some changes were accepted, while other portions received comments that SACAB now needs to review and respond to keep the policy moving forward.
- We are also beginning to look at student outreach around this issue, including a possible survey/flyer and future forum or workshop where students can tell us how immigration concerns are affecting their education, sense of safety, and well-being, and what they want SACAB to advocate for.

Student Led Organization Rep: Friday's meeting was about Tivoli reimagined. Spoke with team members throughout the week about this process.

Knowing that AMC, Lowry and president all are expected to be involved in other campuses so we must compensate for the drive, time and effort to do the role effectively. Wondering about stipend increase bill and how to help members putting in extra hours.

Make students aware of fees and the resources available to them. We have to be sure that the fee is not going to increase because we want to communicate accurately, how can we improve the parking issues for students? Suggesting parking alternatives and solutions. How can we use our funds to better support and have permanent resource for students.

Should we have a priority list because we have pressing matters to complete for SGA before guests are approved to come.

Stipend payment communication, clarity, transparency on stipends and how they are deposited.
