Abbreviations, Definitions & Symbols

Accelerated: A fast-paced, intensive learning option to complete course work in less time than a full semester. Accelerated courses are scheduled usually for the first or second half of a semester.

Corequisite: A course you must take during the same semester

Prerequisite: A course you must have taken during any semester before this one, or an appropriate test series must have been completed.

Hybrid Course: Course with both in-class sessions and online meetings, exercises, and/or scheduled discussions-

Late Start Course: A class that starts at least two weeks after the traditional start date.

Co-Requisite Course: Two classes are paired and taught back-to-back by the same faculty/instructor and are both required for students to attend in which students, ideas, and resources are linked to create a supportive learning environment. Students must register for both classes.

Online Courses: CCD online courses are listed in the schedule and are identified by section numbers that begin with "7." CO Online courses are identified by section numbers that begin with "Z"
