What does stackable mean?

Stackable" refers to a type of educational credential where students can earn a certificate and then build upon it to achieve a higher level credential, like an associate's degree, without having to repeat coursework. This allows for flexibility and allows students to enter and exit their education path with greater ease, while still accumulating the credits needed to achieve a degree.
