


## Microsoft Office: Quick Navigation to Troubleshoot

This support guide provides options for quick navigation and troubleshooting with Microsoft (MS) Office applications, such as Word, PowerPoint, and Excel.


### Option 1: Tell me what you want to do

1. 'Tell me what you want to do' is a search tool located in the ribbon in MS Office applications like Word, PowerPoint, and Excel.




- 'Tell me what you want to do' shortcut key is ALT + Q

2. Users can enter words or phrases to quickly find the tool, function, or command they want to use in their document, presentation, and sheet.



3. If the user needs more information on a certain tool, function or command, users can click on the "Get Help" to learn more.

4. When users need quick access to online resources, web searches, images, definitions and more, click on Smart Lookup to support in completing tasks.
