

Faculty & Adjunct Instructor Loyalty Oath

As a condition of employment or continued employment with Community College of Denver, Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 22-61-104, requires that "Every person employed to teach in any state university, college, junior college, community college, or technical college in the state of Colorado, before entering upon or continuing the discharge of his duties, shall take the following oath or affirmation; except that no person employed to teach in a temporary capacity who is a citizen of a nation other than the United States shall be required to take such oath or affirmation."

"I solemnly (swear) (affirm) that I will uphold the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the state of Colorado, and I will faithfully perform the duties of the position upon which I am about to enter."

This oath shall be filed in each employee's official employment file in the College's Human Resources Office. Failure to sign and return this oath may result in termination of your employment with the College.
