Official Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SCHOLARSHIP. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT WILL NOT INCREASE THE CHANCE OF WINNING.

Sponsor and Administrator

The sponsor of this promotion is **Community College of Denver**, 800 Curtis Street, Denver, CO 80204, in coordination with the **Community College of Denver Foundation** (collectively, the “Sponsor”). The Sponsor is responsible for administering the promotion in accordance with these Official Rules.

Agreement to Official Rules

By participating in this promotion, each entrant fully and unconditionally agrees to and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding in all matters related to the promotion, subject to applicable law.

Promotion Description

The New City Hawks Scholarship (the “Promotion”) is a PROMOTION in which eligible students attending the Welcome New CityHawks event, can enter for a chance to win **one of two scholarship prizes**, each with a value of \$500, courtesy of the CCD Foundation.

The drawing will occur at the conclusion of the event, and winners must be present at the time of the drawing to claim a scholarship prize.

Promotion Period

The Promotion begins on **8/8/2026 at 10.00am (MT)** and ends at the conclusion of the Welcome New City Hawks event on 8/8/2026 at 2.00pm (MT) (the “Promotion Period”). The scholarship drawing is expected to occur at or near the end of the event, at a time determined by the Sponsor.

Eligibility

The Promotion is open only to individuals who, at the time of entry and drawing:

- New CCD Students
- Attend the Welcome New City Hawks event;
- Are enrolled in **credit-bearing coursework** at Community College of Denver;
- Are physically present at the event at the time of the scholarship drawing;
- Satisfy all applicable CCD Foundation scholarship requirements; and **(need any foundation requirements)**
- Comply with these Official Rules.

International students are **eligible** to enter and win, provided they satisfy the eligibility requirements above and any applicable scholarship eligibility or disbursement requirements of the CCD Foundation and Community College of Denver.

The following individuals are not eligible to win: employees directly responsible for administering the Promotion, as well as any immediate family members or persons living in the same household of such individuals.

How to Enter

During the Promotion Period, eligible students who attend the Welcome New CityHawks event and sign-into the event and also express interest in winning the scholarships will receive one automatic entry into the scholarship drawing, subject to verification of eligibility.

No purchase, donation, payment, or separate application fee will be required to enter or win.

Limit **one (1) entry per eligible person** unless the Sponsor publishes a different limit in event materials. Any attempt to obtain more than the stated number of entries by any means may result in disqualification, in the Sponsor’s discretion.

Prize Description and Approximate Retail Value

The following prizes will be awarded:

Prize	Quantity	Approximate Retail Value
New CityHawk Scholarship	2	\$500 each

The total approximate retail value of the two scholarship prizes is **\$1,000**

Each scholarship prize is subject to verification of eligibility and to any CCD Foundation or institutional requirements governing scholarship award processing, posting, disbursement, taxation, use restrictions, enrollment status, and compliance. Scholarship prizes are non-transferable except as determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion or as required by law.

Other small promotional logo items will be shared with the general attendees. These lesser value separate promotional items and are not part of the scholarship drawing.

Odds of Winning

The odds of winning a scholarship prize depend on the total number of eligible entrants who attend the event, remain present at the time of the drawing, and satisfy all scholarship eligibility requirements.

Winner Selection and Notification

Potential scholarship winners will be selected in a random drawing from among all eligible entries received during the Promotion Period. The drawing will be conducted at the conclusion of the Welcome New City Hawks event by the Sponsor or its designated representative.

To be declared a winner, a selected entrant must be physically present when the entrant's name is announced and must satisfy all eligibility and verification requirements. If a selected entrant is not present, is ineligible, declines the prize, cannot satisfy scholarship requirements, or otherwise fails to comply with these Official Rules, that entrant may be disqualified and an alternate entrant may be selected by random drawing from the remaining eligible entries, time permitting.

Verification and Award Conditions

Potential winners may be required to present identification, student status verification, enrollment information, and any other documentation reasonably requested by the Sponsor or the

CCD Foundation to confirm eligibility and process the scholarship award. Failure to timely provide required documentation may result in disqualification.

Award of a scholarship prize is contingent upon the winner's satisfaction of all CCD Foundation and institutional scholarship requirements. If a selected entrant cannot legally or administratively receive the scholarship for any reason, the Sponsor reserves the right to select an alternate winner unless prohibited by applicable policy or law.

Distribution and Receipt of Funds

All scholarship funds will be awarded through the Financial Aid office. Winners may be eligible for a refund if tuition and fees have been paid at the time of award. Contact the Financial Aid office for more information about how scholarships are applied to student accounts.

Taxes and Financial Aid Considerations

Winners are solely responsible for any federal, state, or local taxes associated with receipt of a prize, to the extent applicable. In addition, receipt of a scholarship prize may affect a winner's financial aid package, student account, or other education-related funding, and winners should consult the appropriate CCD or Foundation office regarding award treatment.

Publicity Release

Except where prohibited by law or institutional policy, acceptance of a prize constitutes the winner's consent for the Sponsor and its designees to use the winner's name, likeness, biographical information, statements, and hometown for promotional, educational, or publicity purposes in any media now known or later developed, worldwide, without additional notice, review, approval, or compensation.

Privacy

Privacy and Use of Information

By participating in the Promotion, entrants acknowledge and agree that any information collected in connection with the Promotion may be used by Community College of Denver and the CCD Foundation for promotion administration, winner verification, scholarship processing, and related institutional purposes. Such information will be handled in accordance with applicable law, institutional privacy practices, and any applicable FERPA-related or Foundation disclosure requirements.

Release and Limitation of Liability

By participating, each entrant agrees, to the fullest extent permitted by law, to release and hold harmless the Sponsor, the CCD Foundation, and each of their respective trustees, officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives, successors, and assigns from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the Promotion or receipt or use of any prize, except where such release is otherwise prohibited by law.

The Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, inaccurate, or misdirected entries or eligibility records; technical, electronic, or administrative errors; or any other error that may affect the administration of the Promotion, except as required by law.

Reservation of Rights

The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion and to the extent permitted by law, to cancel, suspend, modify, or terminate the Promotion if fraud, technical failure, administrative error, public safety concerns, force majeure, or any other factor impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Promotion. In such event, the Sponsor reserves the right to award the prizes from among eligible, non-suspect entries received before the time of impairment, if feasible and legally permissible.

The Sponsor further reserves the right to disqualify any individual found to be tampering with the entry process or operation of the Promotion or acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner.

Governing Law and Venue

These Official Rules and the Promotion are governed by the laws of the State of Colorado, without regard to conflict of law principles, except to the extent superseded by applicable federal law. Any dispute relating to the Promotion shall be resolved in a court of competent jurisdiction located in Colorado, subject to applicable governmental immunity, institutional requirements, and mandatory law.
