Quick rundown of elections

- Slides available made by April running down process and loose-timeline
 - Feb 13th first dates for in-person proposals.
 - Vice-President will be appointed today.
 - Sydney reminds us that we can make flyers put on T.V.s, or flyers with QR codes about interest.

Request from Student on SACAB asking us to not appoint new SACAB representatives so SACAB can't meet quorum.

- Sydney expresses confusion about what end goal here is; it has been expressed by some that there are elements of SACAB who feel unheard.
- Devynn was also approached regarding this. Two facets being considered are bill @ Colorado Legislature, and concerns about AHEC treatment of students. There has been one resignation letter from SACAB.
- Jared B. w/ CU Denver from SACAB and CU SGA is in attendance. Is chair of SACAB. SACAB is the student voice of students interfacing with AHEC. Unique challenges with setup on Auraria Campus, including changes to AHEC needing to go through State law. Prior SACAB reps from MSU have been kicked off SACAB based on credit-hour requirements. Request for CCD to send representatives to SACAB. Initiatives in SACAB including RTD Passes, accessibility of menstrual products on campus.
- Per Sydney there was a lack of voiced student disagreement on SACAB meetings, hence surprise around resignation.
- Isaias voices that he has had a positive experience on SACAB, echoes that it is a unique opportunity for students to create meaningful impact on campus. Believes that issue has stemmed from a misunderstanding about how AHEC works.
- Devynn argues that part of the problem isn't necessarily misunderstanding, but that the array of complexities regarding operation is a source of frustration itself.
- Per Jared, ABOD is having a large meeting next Wednesday that they will attend. Normal position that attends stepped down, so is stepping in to fill that role. Is inviting some students from each of the schools to give 60 second comments at the meeting. Will be from 8a-10a.
- Devynn and Dom will be attending the ABOD meeting.
