#### 1. PURPOSE

<u>Auraria Higher Education Center (AHEC) Policy – Use of Golf Carts</u> outlines operating rules and safety guidelines related to the operation of golf carts for employees who work on the Auraria Campus.

# 2. APPLICABILITY

These guidelines apply to all Community College of Denver (College) employees who operate electric and gas powered small size utility/service carts (golf carts) on the Auraria Campus.

# 3. DEFINITIONS

Golf Carts – Electric and gas powered small size utility/service cart.

#### 4. POLICY

All employees operating a cart must adhere to all operating rules and safety guidelines outlined in <u>AHEC Policy – Use of Golf Carts</u>, as well all applicable vehicle and traffic laws of the State of Colorado and the City and County of Denver.

### 5. GUIDELINES

### a. Employees:

- Must have a current, valid driver's license and must have it on his/her possession at all times during the operation of a golf cart.
- ii. Must pass a certification test, conducted by AHEC, prior to operation of a golf cart.
- iii. Are responsible for understanding and complying with AHEC Policy – Use of Golf Carts and these guidelines.
- iv. Who operate a golf cart on the Auraria Campus must complete a <u>driver's license certification</u>, which will be maintained in the employee's personnel file in the Human Resource Department.

#### b. Supervisors:

 Are responsible for ensuring employees who operate golf carts receive training on the operation and safety of each vehicle they will be responsible for operating. ii. Are responsible for providing a copy of <u>AHEC Policy – Use</u> of <u>Golf Carts</u> and these guidelines to the employee and ensuring the employee understands its contents.
