Bill History

WHEREAS, CCD students pay a Student Government Operations/Student Activity Fee that supports Student Programming, Activities & Resource Center (SPARC) programs and services, including CCD Student Government Association

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association (SGA) exists to represent and advocate for the diverse voices of the student body, foster community among students, and recognize the dedication and hard work of its members and executive officers throughout the academic year;

WHEREAS, hosting an end-of-year celebration event promotes student engagement, recognizes student leadership contributions, and strengthens the sense of community within CCD SGA;

WHEREAS, the Clear Creek area provides a suitable and accessible outdoor venue for a community gathering event that reflects the spirit and culture of the Denver metro area;

WHEREAS, providing a catered Mediterranean food experience with beverages and dessert supports a welcoming and inclusive event environment for all participating students;

WHEREAS, CCD SGA has the authority to allocate funds from its operating budget to support official SGA programming, events, and community-building activities;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Student Government Association of the Community College of Denver, AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1: Appropriation and Stipend Authorization

1. CCD SGA authorizes the planning and hosting of an End of Year Celebration Event for SGA members, officers, and invited guests at the conclusion of the Spring 2026 academic semester.
2. The event shall be held at the Clear Creek area in the greater Denver metro region, at a date and time to be confirmed by the SGA President and Advisor(s).
3. The event shall include a catered Mediterranean food spread, non-alcoholic beverages, and bundt cake(s) as dessert.
4. The SGA President, Vice President, and Advisor(s) shall coordinate event logistics, including venue selection, catering arrangements, and attendance management.

Section 2: Budget Appropriation

1. CCD SGA authorizes a total expenditure of up to \$1,000 for the End of Year Celebration Event.
2. Funds shall be allocated from the CCD SGA General/Operating Budget and shall be used exclusively for food, beverages, and dessert procurement from a Mediterranean food vendor.
3. The Treasurer shall coordinate with SGA Advisors to ensure all purchases comply with CCD financial policies and procurement procedures.
4. Receipts and documentation for all expenditures must be submitted to the Treasurer for record-keeping and budget reconciliation.
5. Any unused funds from this allocation shall revert to the CCD SGA General/Operating Budget following the conclusion of the event.

Section 3: Budget Oversight and Compliance

1. The event is open to all current CCD SGA officers, members, and any guests formally invited by SGA leadership.
2. Final attendance and headcount shall be confirmed in advance to facilitate accurate catering orders and budget management.
3. SGA Advisors shall maintain oversight of event participation and ensure compliance with CCD student activity policies.
4. All expenditures must comply with CCD financial policies, student activity fund regulations, and applicable procurement guidelines.

5. The Treasurer, in coordination with SGA Advisors, shall oversee disbursement and documentation of all event-related expenditures.
6. A final expenditure report shall be submitted to SGA Advisors following the conclusion of the event.
