Motion to Suspend Orders of Day to Discuss Special Elections (Case)

- Passes (Unanimous)
- Case says it has brought to his attention that Special Elections as they are being carried out aren't in accordance with Bylaws and Election code.
 - Namely, Special Elections must be voted on by Student Body, and we must Establish an Election Committee.
- Devynn states that this was done last year and that Tina, who helped with elections, can be reached out for guidance.
 - Also states that formerly there was a Bylaws Committee; this could potentially come back to help us follow Bylaws and prepare to edit them to come to the next election.
- Plan to establish a committee; timeline will be pushed back so that elections can be in accordance with the bylaws.
 - Intent Forms would be due Feb 16, voting week would be March 2nd to 6
 - The committee can be staffed by outgoing SGA members.
