## **VIII. Open Form:**

Isaias was planning to propose a bill asking for 4-5 thousand dollars to allocate money for SGA that we can use to purchase SWAG for tabling events to be made available when we need it.

- Dominic expresses interest in helping Isaias create such a bill.
- Also wants to allocate money to training, leadership courses, etc.
- Maybe have a conference with other professionals to help SGA members gain experience and represent CCD

Isaias was also interviewed by CU's Student Newspaper about the process of helping to create SB26-034, also about relationships with SACAB, ABOD, etc.

Isaias has also undertaken the task of looking through bylaws and creating drafts to rework them from the ground up.

- Timeline of 8-12 months to complete.
- We can ask CCD's attorneys to help with the drafting process.
- Reiterates problems with interpretation, clarity, etc.
- Brings up questions regarding division of power, potential for name change, wants SGA to be independent branch of CCD.
- Nicole states that regardless of whether there will always be oversight by an administrator, asks for conversation to be had.
  - Also, states there will always be restrictions when handling funds that are derived from student fees.
- Kloe states we still have a high budget, especially in comparison to other student-led organizations.

Interest in reaching out to the library again thru Sydney to do student facing work, making videos, etc.
