Bill History

WHEREAS, CCD students pay a Student Government Operations/Student Activity Fee that supports Student Programming, Activities & Resource Center (SPARC) programs and services, including CCD Student Government Association

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association (SGA) exists to represent and advocate for the diverse voices of the student body and relies on the active participation and dedication of its elected and appointed members throughout the academic year

WHEREAS, SGA members contribute significant time and effort to representing student interests, attending meetings, participating in governance, and supporting SGA initiatives beyond normal academic commitments;

WHEREAS, the month of May 2026 represents the final active month of the Spring 2026 semester, during which SGA members are expected to fulfill end-of-year responsibilities including final meetings, reporting, and transition planning;

WHEREAS, providing a one-time stipend increase of \$100 for the month of May 2026 recognizes the additional time commitments and contributions of SGA members during the close of the academic year;

WHEREAS, CCD SGA has the authority to allocate funds from its operating budget to support official SGA programming, events, and community-building activities;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Student Government Association of the Community College of Denver, AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1: Appropriation and Stipend Authorization

1. CCD SGA authorizes a one-time stipend increase of \$100 per eligible SGA member for the month of May 2026.
2. This increase is in addition to any existing stipend currently received by eligible SGA members and applies solely to the month of May 2026.
3. The total allocation shall be calculated based on the number of eligible SGA members at the time of passage.
4. Funds shall be allocated from the CCD SGA General/Operating Budget.

Section 2: Budget Appropriation

1. To be eligible, a member must hold an active SGA position and be in good standing at the time of disbursement.
2. Members must fulfill all required duties and maintain eligibility requirements set forth by the SGA Constitution, Bylaws, and CCD governing documents throughout the month of May 2026.
3. The stipend increase shall be disbursed in accordance with CCD payroll and student employment processes.
4. Failure to maintain eligibility or fulfill required duties during May 2026 may result in forfeiture of the stipend increase in accordance with SGA procedures.

Section 3: Budget Oversight and Compliance

1. All stipend payments must comply with CCD financial policies, student employment regulations, and applicable tax reporting requirements.
2. The Treasurer, in coordination with SGA Advisors, shall oversee the execution, tracking, and documentation of all stipend disbursements.
3. Any unused allocated funds shall revert to the CCD SGA General/Operating Budget at the conclusion of the Spring 2026 semester.
