Bill History

In many cases, students will finish a class and toss their used textbooks in a corner of their room and never use them again. Moe Prante, in coordination with Carol Miller, Chair of the Faculty Council, will organize an event that will reach out to students that do not usually donate their books, and encourage them to do so through a large scale donation event with an incentive. The Textbook Give Back event will allow all students to conveniently donate their textbooks to the Lending Library at the Community College of Denver. Each student who donates their textbook will be entering into a drawing for a free iPad Mini, which will be provided by the Student Government Association.

Bill Summary

The Textbook Give Back is a chance for students to donate their textbook during the last week of the semester to their professors, who will then pass those books onto the Lending Library to later be given to students in need of a textbook for that class. The event promotes donating textbooks among the general population as opposed to just the students who always donate their books. The give back will provide a sense of community and give those who don't normally donate their book incentive to do so. For each textbook in "good" condition that students donate to their professor, they will receive one entry into a drawing for an iPad Mini. Once the semester has ended and all textbook entry slips and textbooks have been collected from the professors and passed off to Student Government, a winner will be chosen from the entries.

Bill Status: APPROVED

The event will utilize one iPad Mini from the CCD Student Government inventory as a grand prize. Collection of the entry slips and textbook from professors will be facilitated by Moe Prante and Lexus Porter on behalf of Student Government, and in coordination with Carol Miller, Chair of the Faculty Council. The textbook collection will be held from May 2nd to May 9th. The winner will be chosen and contacted the morning of May 10th to come into the Student Life Office and collect their iPad Mini prize.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Student Government Association of the Community College of Denver, AS FOLLOWS;

<u>Section 1:</u> The Textbook Give Back requires reservation of one iPad mini from the current SGA inventory.

<u>Section 2:</u> This bill takes effect upon passage by the Student Government Association, and upon obtaining the signatures of the SGA President and SGA Advisor.
