Introduction to Advisor Plans:


Overview:

The **Advisor Plans** feature allows customized academic roadmaps created by your academic advisor to help you stay on track toward graduation. These plans outline which courses you should take and when, based on your program requirements and academic progress. By reviewing and accepting an advisor plan in Navigate360, you can efficiently plan future semesters and ensure you're meeting degree requirements.

Getting Started with Advisor Plans:

- Accessing the Advisor Plans on Desktop
 - 1.1. Access Navigate Three Sixty

On the C-C-D Connect dashboard, click Navigate Three Sixty - Student Home. This will take you to the Navigate Three Sixty Student Home page, called Explore.



1.2. Access the Planner Section

On the left-hand side top of the explore page, select the 'Planner' tab to open the **Planner** section. The planner consists of three columns:

Left: Planning Tools


Middle: Course Planning Playground

1.3. Select and Accept the Advisor Plan

On the left side of the Planner, scroll down to find the **Advisor Plans** dropdown menu. Click on the plan you want to accept. It will open in the middle window. At the top right of this window, click the **three dots** icon to open the dropdown menu. From here, you can:

View advisor comments

Show completed terms


Add the entire plan or portions of it to your schedule




1.4. Add Courses to Terms




