#### **Introduction to Resources:**


#### Overview:

### **Getting Started with Resources:**

- 1. Accessing Resources on Desktop
  - 1.1. Access Navigate Three Sixty

On the **C-C-D Connect dashboard**, click on **Navigate Three Sixty - Student Home**. This will take you to the **Navigate Three Sixty Student Home** page, also called **Explore**.

On the left-hand side of the **Explore** page, select the **Resource** icon. This will open the resource feature where you can find various support options.


1.3. Categories

On the left-hand side of the **Explore** page, select the **Resource** icon. This will open the resource feature where you can find various support options.




