#### **Introduction to Study Buddies:**


Overview:

1.2. Access Study Buddies


On the left-hand side, select the **Study Buddies** icon to open the Study Buddies feature.







  - 2.1. Access Navigate Three Sixty Mobile Application Download our mobile app from the app store. Once downloaded, select the application from your mobile device.





On the explore tab, select the **Study Buddies** icon to open the Study Buddies feature.




