Introduction to Notifications:


Overview:

Getting Started with Notifications

- Accessing Notifications on Desktop
 - 1.1. Access Navigate Three Sixty

On the C-C-D Connect dashboard, click Navigate Three Sixty - Student Home. This will take you to the Navigate Three Sixty Student Home page, called Explore.




1.2. Access Notifications

Click the **bell icon** in the top-right corner to open your **Notification Center**.






1.3. View Notifications

Read and click on any notification to see more details or take action.




- 1.4. Manage Notifications & Stay Updated




