#### Overview:

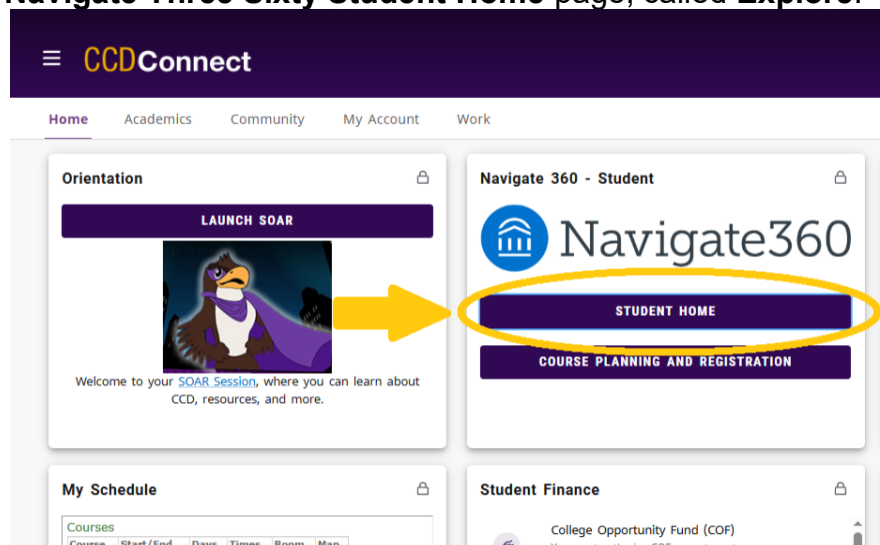

### Getting Started with Notifications

#### 1. Accessing Notifications on Desktop

##### 1.1. Access Navigate Three Sixty

On the **C-C-D Connect dashboard**, click **Navigate Three Sixty - Student Home**. This will take you to the **Navigate Three Sixty Student Home** page, called **Explore**.

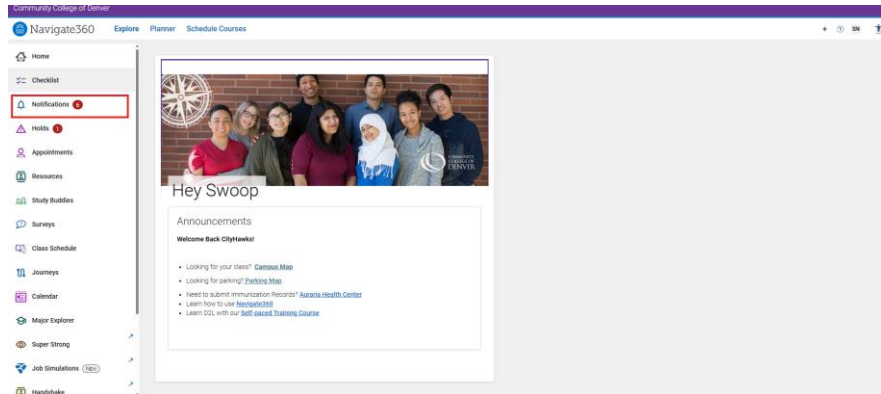


##### 1.2. Access Notifications

Click the **bell icon** in the top-right corner to open your **Notification Center**.

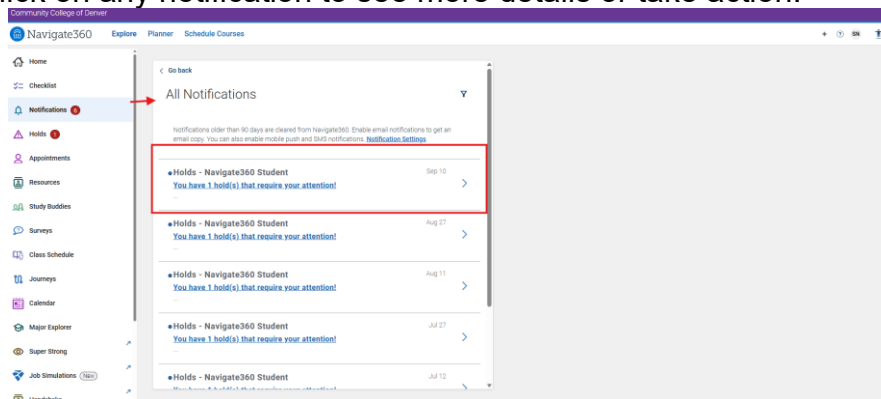

### 1.3. View Notifications

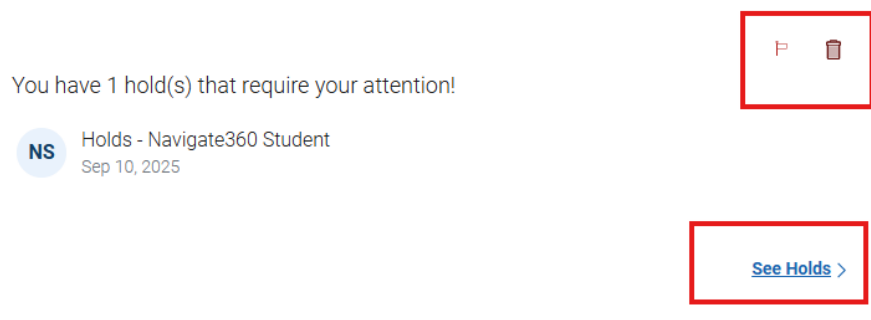
Read and click on any notification to see more details or take action.

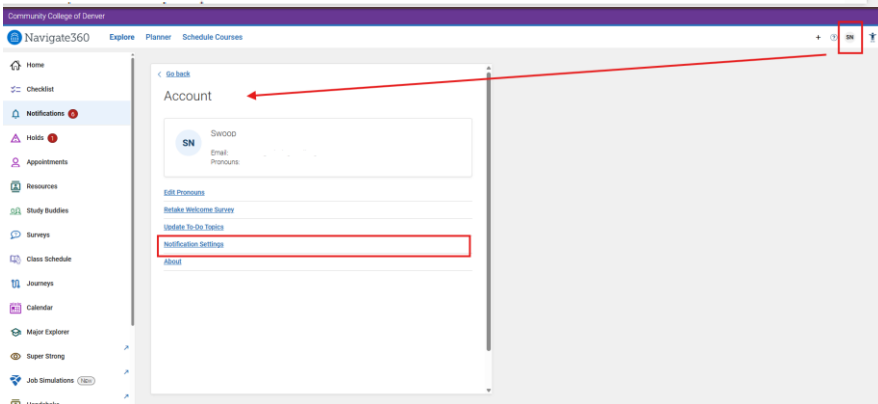

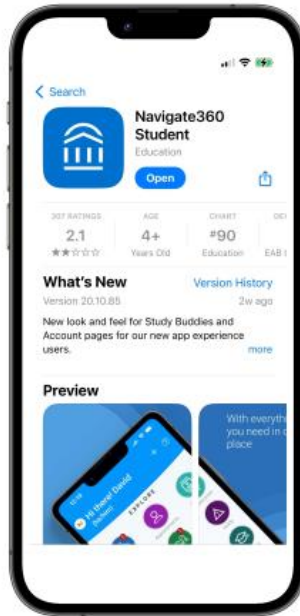

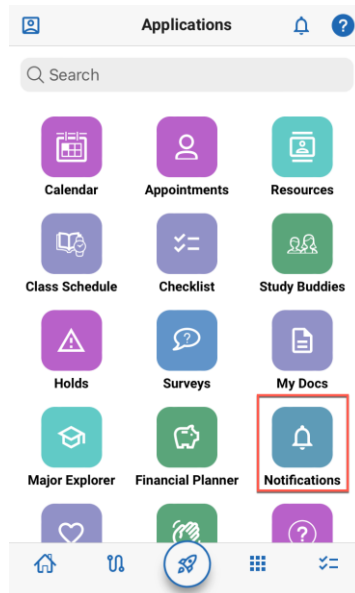
## Notifications

Click the **bell icon** to open your **Notification Center**.

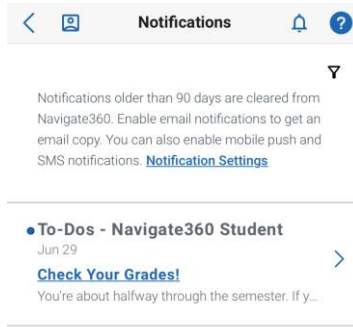

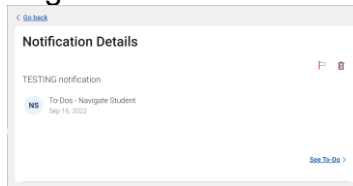

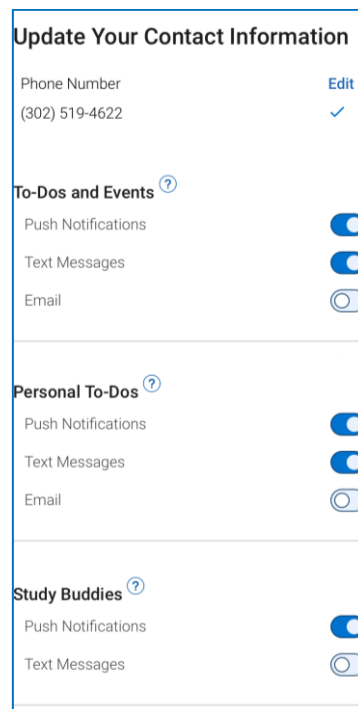


### 2.4. Manage Notifications & Stay Updated
