Overview:

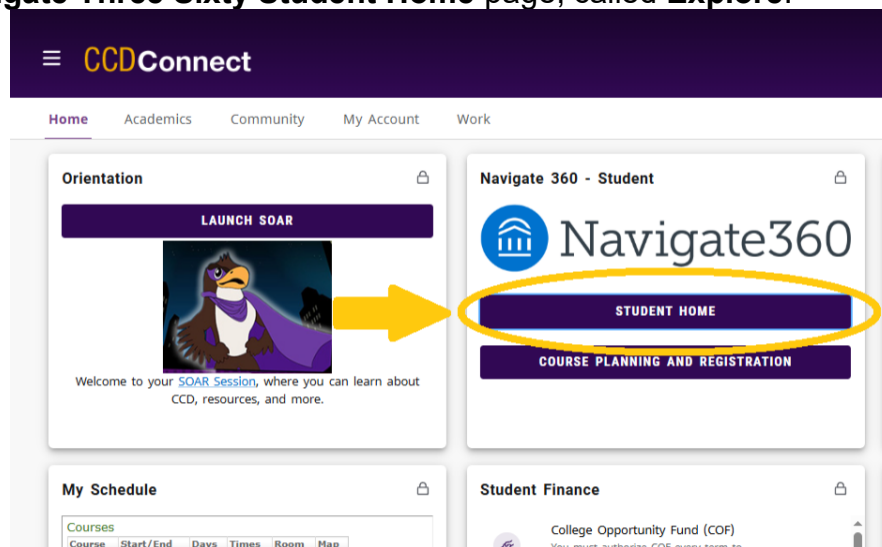
The **Major Explorer** feature helps students explore and choose the right academic path by providing tools like a survey to match interests with potential majors, viewing placement test results, and scheduling meetings with academic advisors. It allows students to save majors of interest for easy reference, helping them make informed decisions about their academic and career goals.

Getting Started with Major Explorer:

1. Accessing Major Explorer on Desktop

1.1. Access Navigate Three Sixty

On the **CCD Connect dashboard**, click **Navigate Three Sixty - Student Home**. This will take you to the **Navigate Three Sixty Student Home** page, called **Explore**.

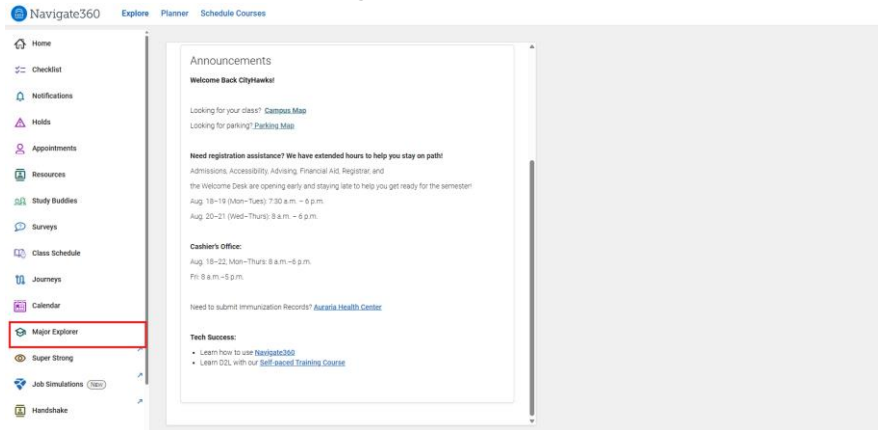


1.2. Access Major Explorer

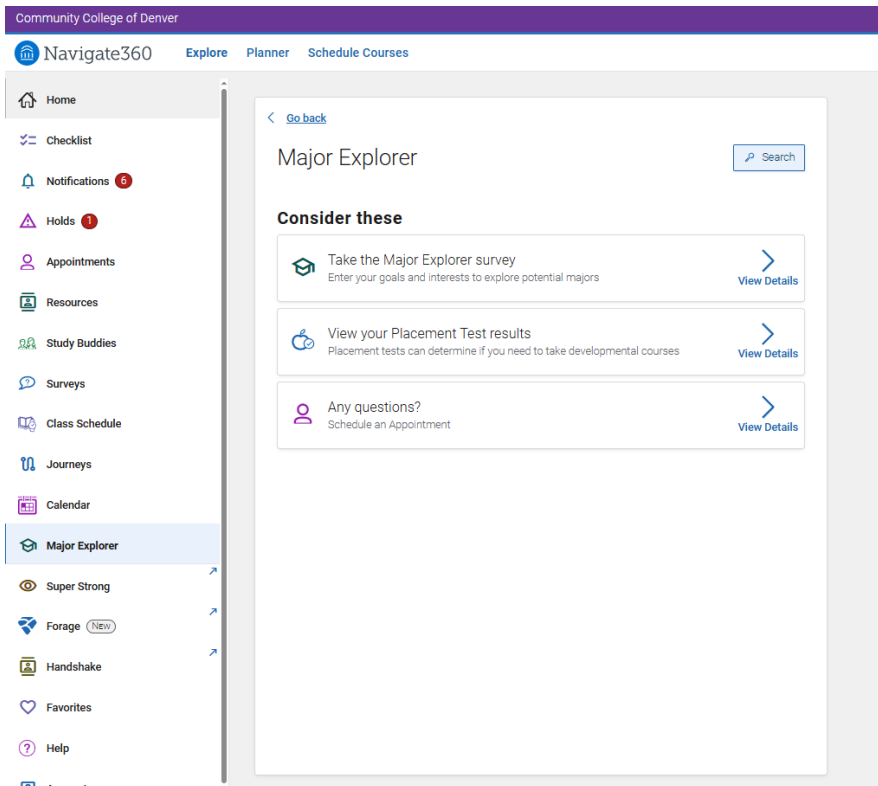


1.3. Considerations

There are three key options:

- **Take the Major Explorer Survey:** If you haven't already, complete a six-part questionnaire to help identify the major that best suits your interests.
- **View Placement Test Results:** If you've taken placement tests, check out the recommendations based on your results.
- **Schedule a Meeting with Your Academic Advisor:** If you have questions about your survey results or major, meet with your advisor to discuss your options and align your academic plan with your career goals.

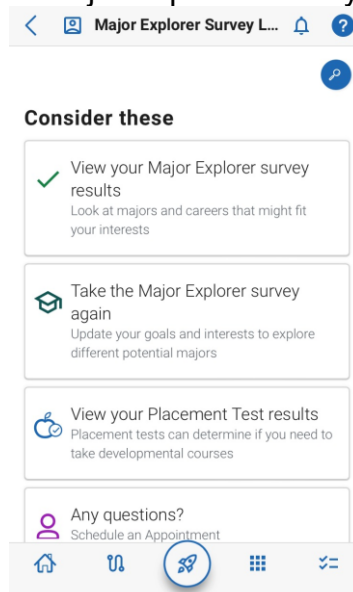
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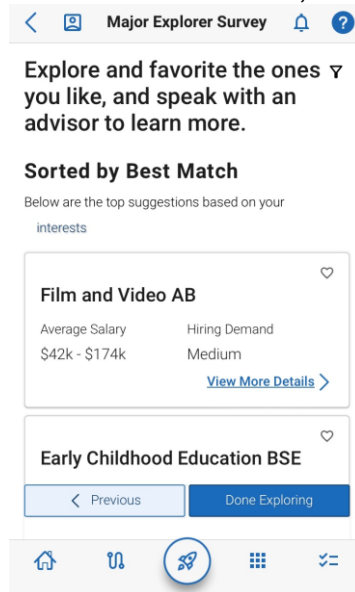
