Introduction to Handshake:


Overview:

This tool supports career growth and prepares students for the workforce.

Getting Started with Handshake:

- Accessing the Handshake on Desktop
 - 1.1. Access Navigate Three Sixty

On the C-C-D Connect dashboard, click Navigate Three Sixty - Student Home. This will take you to the Navigate Three Sixty Student Home page, called Explore.




1.2. Access Handshake



1.3. Sign In or Create an Account with Handshake


If you already have a Handshake account, click **Sign In** to log in. If you're new to Handshake, follow the on-screen instructions to create an account with your student details.

Once logged in, explore the job and internship listings. You can filter opportunities by career interests, location, and other criteria to find relevant options.




1.5. Apply for Jobs and Events
