Overview:

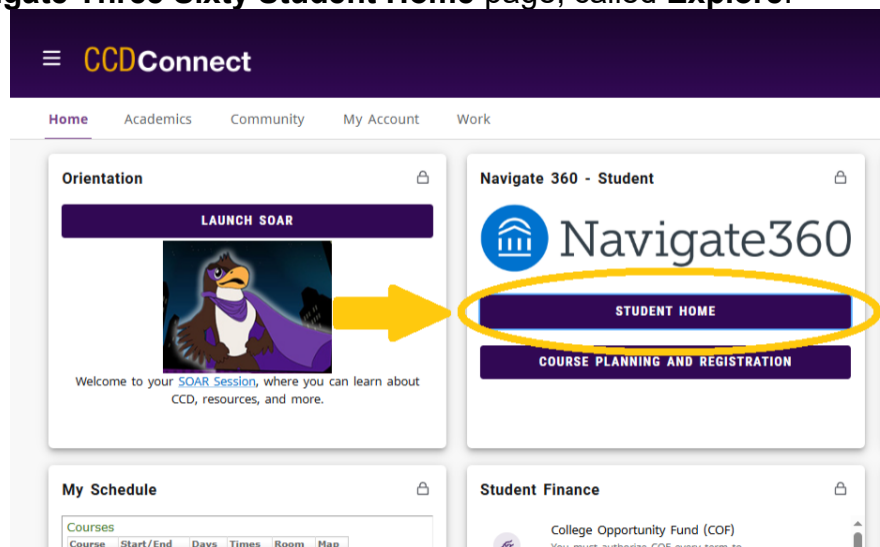

Getting Started with Favorites:

1. Accessing the Favorites on Desktop

1.1. Access Navigate Three Sixty

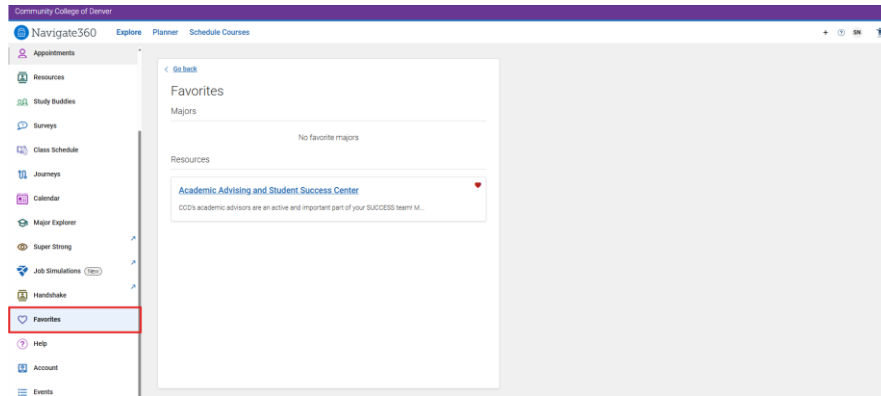
On the **CCD Connect dashboard**, click **Navigate Three Sixty - Student Home**. This will take you to the **Navigate Three Sixty Student Home** page, called **Explore**.



1.2. Access the Favorites Section

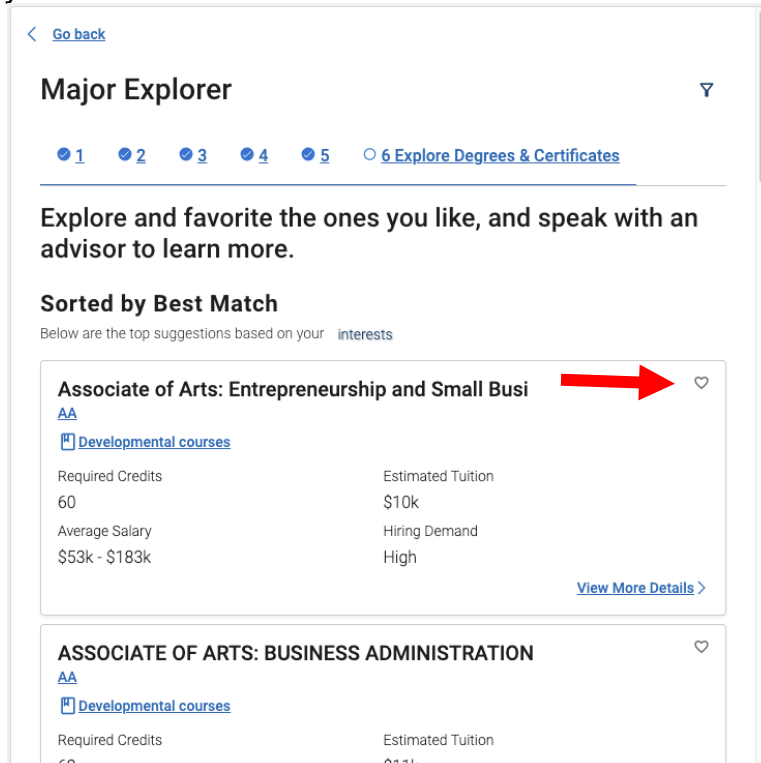
On the left-hand side, select the **Favorites** icon to open the favorites section.

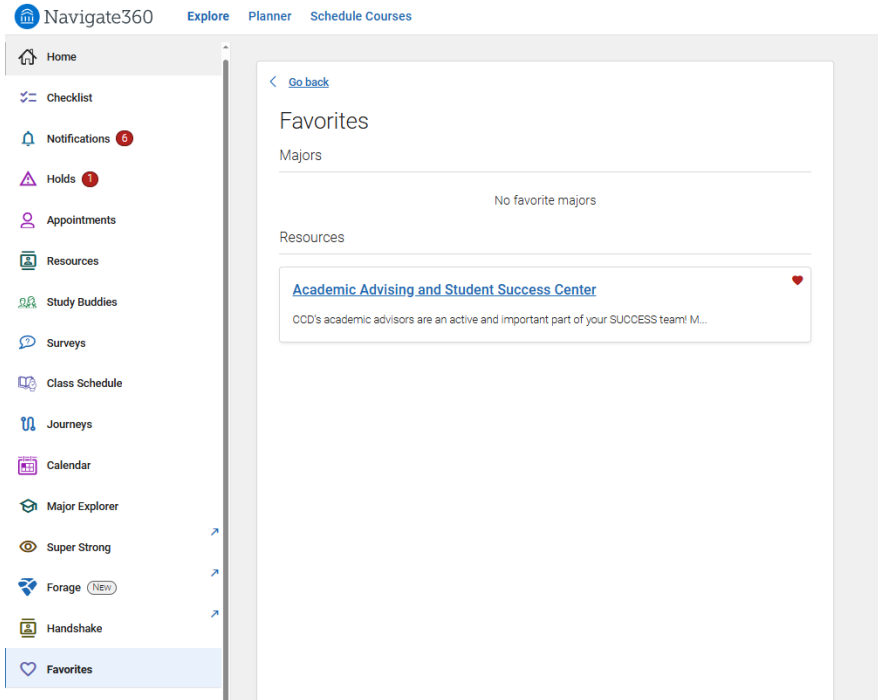


1.4. View Your Favorites

Select the **Favorites** icon to open the favorites section.

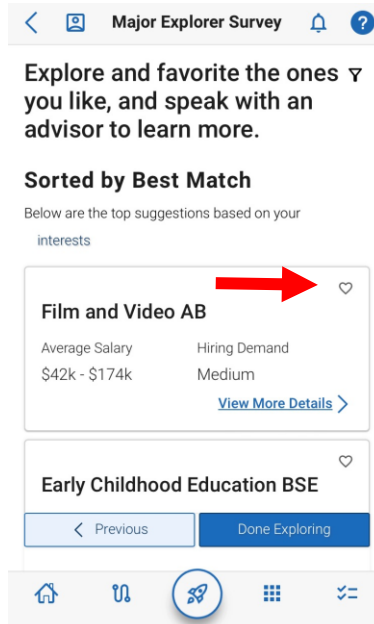

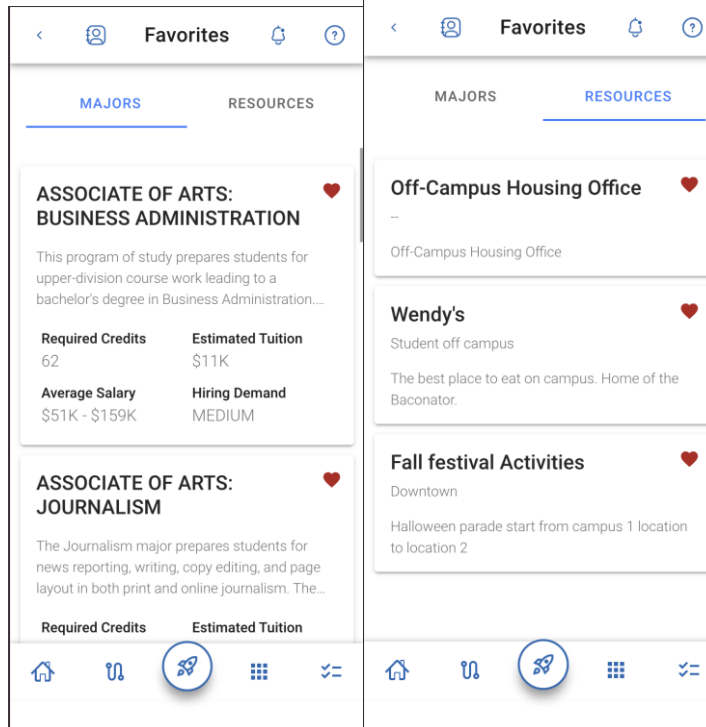


2.4. View Your Favorites
